



Pharmacognosy as "the study of natural product molecules that are useful for their medicinal, ecological, gustatory, or other functional properties." The Department of Pharmacognosy is dedicated to natural and herbal medicinal product research in pharmaceutical sciences. The use interdisciplinary approaches to identify, analyze, and purify multi-component mixtures from plant, fungal, or marine sources focusing on the characterization of their bioactive secondary metabolites. Natural products research often comes across many hurdles, which dims the drug development goals. We believe that natural products research information can potentially benefit many researchers involved in this area. Further researchers believe in combining the strengths of Ayurveda with modern scientific techniques such as NMR, MS and chromatographic techniques to provide new functional leads with high therapeutic value in a short span of time. This department deals with the study of biology, chemistry, biochemistry, taxonomy, and ethnobiology of natural products obtained from plant, animal, marine and other life origins.

Pharmacognosy has undergone significant change in recent years and today represents a highly interdisciplinary science, which is one of the major pillars of Pharmaceutical education.
