

Pharmaceutics: Art and Science of dosage form design

Pharmaceutics is the scientific discipline concerned with the process of creating the dosage form of a therapeutic that is to be used by patients. It encompasses drug formulation and manufacturing.Pharmaceutics is the science of dosage form design. There are many chemicals with known pharmacological properties but a raw chemical is of no use to a patient. Pharmaceutics deals with the formulation of a pure drug substance into a dosage form. Branches of pharmaceutics include: Pharmacokinetics, Pharmacodynamics, Pharmacoepidemiology, Pharmacogenomics, Pharmacovigilance, Pharmaceutical formulation and Pharmaceutical technology.

Research Interest:

Pharmacognosy: Devoted to natural and folklore holistic health

Pharmacognosy as "the study of natural product molecules that are useful for their medicinal, ecological, gustatory, or other functional properties."The Department of Pharmacognosy is dedicated to natural and herbal medicinal product research in pharmaceutical sciences. The use interdisciplinary approaches to identify, analyze, and purify multi-component mixtures from plant, fungal, or marine sources focusing on the characterization of their bioactive secondary metabolites. Natural products research often comes across many hurdles, which dims the drug development goals. We believe that natural products research information can potentially benefit many researchers involved in this area. Further researchers believe in combining the strengths of Ayurveda with modern scientific techniques such as NMR, MS and chromatographic techniques to provide new functional leads with high therapeutic value in a short span of time. This department deals with the study of biology, chemistry, biochemistry, taxonomy, and ethnobiology of natural products obtained from plant, animal, marine and other life origins.

Pharmacognosy has undergone significant change in recent years and today represents a highly interdisciplinary science, which is one of the major pillars of Pharmaceutical education. Areas of active interest include natural products chemistry, isolation, characterization and biological studies of phytoconstitutents using animal models, herbal cosmetics, novel herbal formulations, and their standardization.

Major Research Interest:

- Drug discovery and lead generation from natural sources
- Development of formulation methods, standardization and stability studies of herbal drugs, herbominerals, nutraceuticals and cosmeceuticals of natural origin
- General quality control methods for crude drugs and protocol development for specific medicinal plant materials
- Development of technologies for natural products involving extraction, isolation and quantification
- Ayurvedic formulation development and standardization with novel approaches
- Biological evaluation and validation of medicinal plants in various therapeutic areas like antiacne, antidiabetic, immunomodulatory, antioxidants, antiulcer, and anti-inflammatory.

COURSES OFFERED 2020-21

DIPLOMA COURSE IN PHARMACY (D. PHARM.)

D. Pharm is an entry-level tertiary pharmacy credential. It is a 2-year full-time diploma course designed to prepare candidates to work under the supervision of a licensed pharmacist in hospitals, community pharmacies, and other pharmaceutical-related fields. The basic eligibility criterion for pursuing the course is a 10+2 or equivalent qualification in any stream from a recognized educational board.

Students can enroll in the course after successfully completing higher secondary education in science stream with physics, chemistry and either biology or maths as subjects. After obtaining the diploma, registration with the pharmacy council is required to be a registered pharmacist. A D. Pharm holder can also enroll for a professional (undergraduate) degree course of Bachelor of Pharmacy via lateral entry scheme.

DOCTOR OF PHARMACY (PHARM.D):

The College offers Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm. D.) course; a 06 years full time doctorate level course comprising of 5 years classroom teaching and 1 year of internship in collaboration with Lokmanya Hospital, Pune, a venture of Lokmanya group of hospitals, a multispecialty hospital with team of experienced and dedicated doctors serving people for more than 40 years.

In the Pharm. D. course the major components of pharmacy are emphasized such as Pharmacy Practice, Hospital Pharmacy, Community Pharmacy, Pharmacotherapeutics, Clinical Pharmacy, Biostatistics and Research Methodology, Clinical Toxicology, Clinical Research, Pharmacoepidemiology, Pharmacoeconomics, Clinical Pharmacokinetics, Pharmacotherapeutic Drug Monitoring etc.

Students shall posted in hospital for a period of not less than fifty hours in each of second, third & fourth year course. In the fifth year, every student shall spend half a day attending ward rounds on daily basis. Students will get exposure during internship to conduct actual practice of pharmacy and health care and acquires skills under the supervision of doctors so that he or she may become capable of functioning independently Utilizing ultra-modern facilities of online and offline learning facilities in the College, after completion the course students will be able to provide the clinical pharmacy services such as patient medication counseling in the hospital, work in the areas Clinical research organizations (CRO), Pharmacovigilance, Pharmaco-economics, community services, in research and academics.

M. PHARM (PHARMACEUTICAL CHEMISTRY)

M. Pharm in Pharmaceutical Chemistry deals with the design of lead molecule as per the need of society for the particular disease. Medicinal chemists play a crucial role in the drug discovery process through the selection and synthesis of compounds that establish structure– activity relationships and achieve efficacy and safety in preclinical animal testing. The students will study various field of organic chemistry along with a range of other disciplines to anticipate problems and interpret growth for design of lead compounds by use of various software applicable for docking, homology modeling, QSAR studies as well as isolation, purification of medicinal compounds from natural origin and characterised all compounds by using various modern sophisticated instruments with latest technology.

Area of Interest: Docking study, Homology Modeling, QSAR study, Green synthesis techniques, analytical method development and validation, Preclinical study of synthesized compounds


M. PHARM (PHARMACOLOGY)
