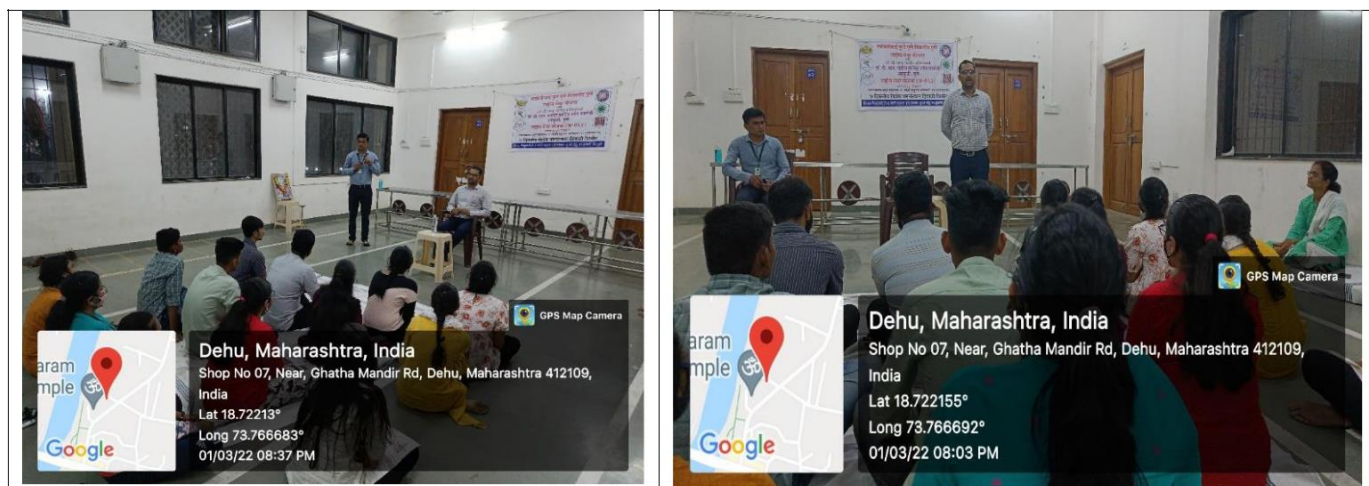

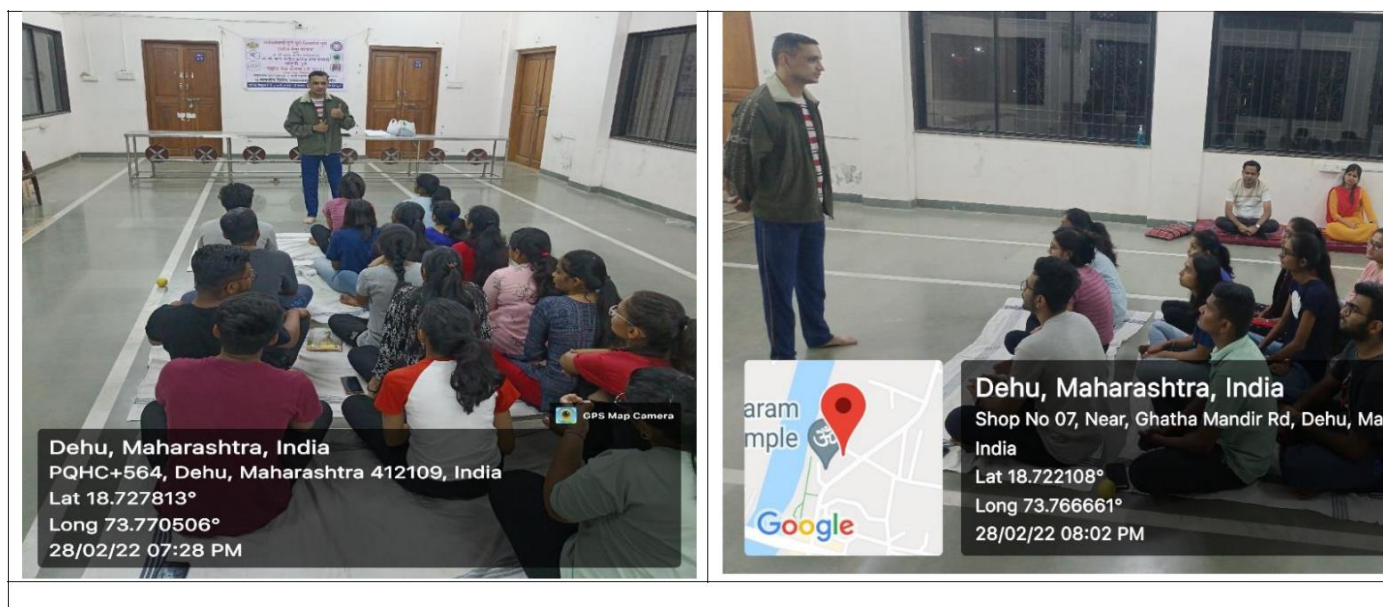

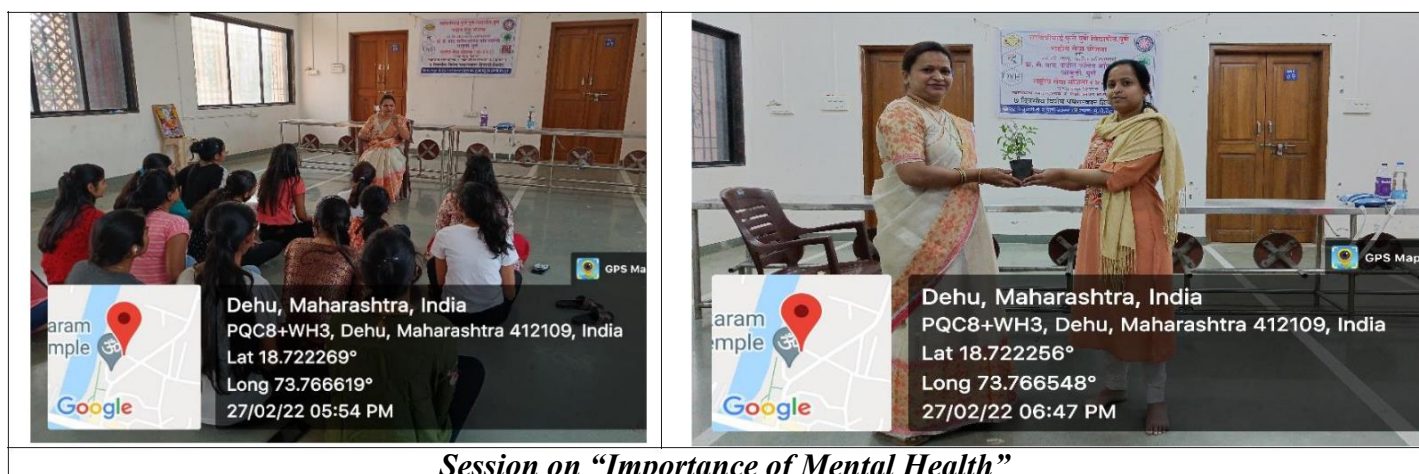

**Report:**

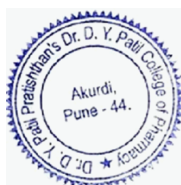

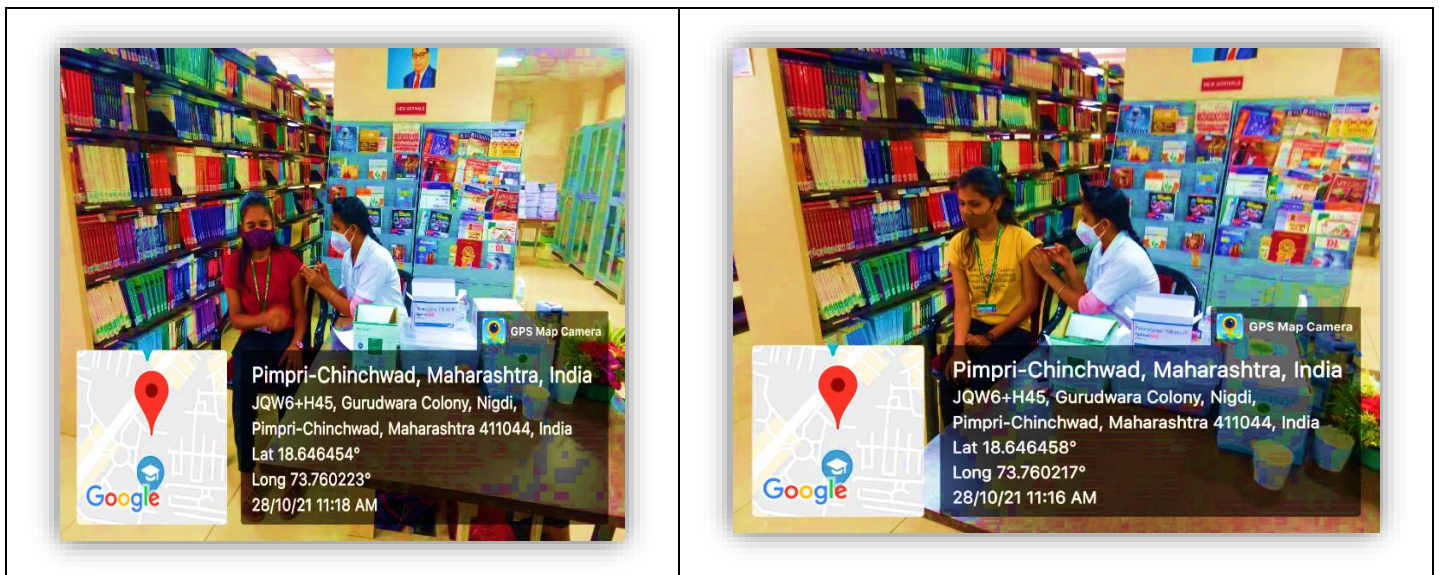
