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Therefore in consideration of mutual covenants set out in this MoU, the parties hereby agree as per the rules & regulations of the Dr. D. Y. Patil College Of Pharmacy and terms & conditions detailed hereunder:

1. **STRATEGY**

Specifically, the following areas have been identified:

- I. Diploma Courses in Clinical Research and Pharmacovigilance
- II. Niche courses in research and other job oriented courses
- III. The above will include diplomas, certificates and other certification as mutually decided
- IV. Delivery will be between online modes, and face to face modes.

2. **JOINT CO-ORDINATION COMMITTEE**

There shall be a joint Co-ordination Committee (hereinafter referred to as "JCC") consisting of representatives from Dr. D. Y. Patil College Of Pharmacy and DCS. The constitution of the JCC shall be Inter alia as follows:

- I. The Campus Director of Dr. D. Y. Patil College Of Pharmacy (or his nominee) will be the Mentor and Chairman or Director of DCS (or his nominee) will be the Chief Advisor.
- II. Besides the Chairman and Co-Chairman, the JCC shall have four more representatives (two nominated by each party) as Member of the committee. The members can be changed at the discretion of the nominating party.
- III. The JCC will approve the program design and its fee for all the joint programs strictly as per rules & regulations of the Dr. D. Y. Patil College Of Pharmacy.
- IV. JCC may constitute an Expert Committee to ensure quality, standards and observance of rules for all academic matters related to curriculum and evaluation for joint programs. The Experts Committee shall consist of such number of members as decided upon by the JCC.

3. **RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES**

The detailed responsibilities of the Parties will be as given below. Each Party will, Inter-alia perform the following responsibilities:

- A. Obligations of Dr. D. Y. Patil College Of Pharmacy as a Education Partner.
  1. Providing all the relevant information and guidelines, if deemed necessary, to give effect to the scope and purpose of this MoU within agreed timelines
  2. Confirm admission and registrations of the students and issue of enrolment numbers and ID cards to registered students.
  3. Will oversee all examinations following its rules and regulations
  4. 1st year, 1 class room required for 40 students strength and from 2nd year, 2 class room required for 40 students strength with chairs/ whiteboard/ projector including furnishing, electricity, water, plumbing, adequate security and Internet for the computer labs and also 2 Faculty workstation with WIFI if required.



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**B. Obligations of DCS as a Implementation Partner.**

1. Admit students provisionally for various Joint Programs, and pass on the documents for approval to Dr. D. Y. Patil College Of Pharmacy as per its rules & regulations.
2. Collect fees through Demand Drafts, cheques or cash from students as per the fee decided by JCC for respective programmes.
3. Fee collection as per Clause 4.
4. Administer education delivery.
5. Scope of Work under Program.
  - Skilling of students.
  - Arranging faculty and scheduling.
  - Delivery of program.
6. Facilitate the examination at regular interval as decided from time to time.
7. Carry out evaluation and assessment as per examination norms of DR. D. Y. PATIL COLLEGE OF PHARMACY.
8. It shall deploy its personnel, team of 2 to 3 at the Dr. D. Y. Patil College Of Pharmacy from 10:00 hrs to 18:00 hrs on all the days in a year except National Holidays and weekly off depends on schedule and any other holiday/s as may be notified by hosting site in this regard.
9. It shall be responsible to comply with all the Appropriate Laws as may be applicable in the State of Maharashtra, in respect of its personnel deployed for imparting training at the CSED.
10. 3-6 months internship period for all successful students as per course design. A certificate will be issued of such internship being carried out by student.
11. DCS will have a placement cell and industries to facilitate the placement process. DCS will invite Industrial speakers and experts on regular intervals.
12. Issue Joint Diploma/ Certificate to all successful candidates within 90 days after completion of examinations.

**C. Joint Obligations**

1. DR. D. Y. PATIL COLLEGE OF PHARMACY and DCS will jointly design and develop the Curriculum for joint programmes.
2. The admission notice will be issued by the parties after consulting each other with the final approval of the Mentor as approved by the University.
3. On the respective websites, Courses and the collaboration agreement will be mentioned as approved by the University.
4. **FEE COLLECTION AND SHARING**
  1. One separate new escrow account in the name of Dr. D. Y. Patil College of Pharmacy, be opened with Oriental Bank of Commerce, Camp Branch, Pune.
  2. DCS and DYPCOP will collect all the fees jointly from students.
  3. DYPCOP will remit 60% of the receipts (including GST) within fortnight for the collections made in the previous month.



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4. We will make this project sustainable on successful registration of minimum 30 students per year.
5. **COURSES and PROPOSED FEES**  
The courses and the fees proposed are depicted in Annexure A, which will be reviewed by the Joint Committee periodically.
6. **CERTIFICATION, ASSESSMENT AND EVALUATION**  
The examination, evaluation, assessment and certification models of THE DR. D. Y. PATIL COLLEGE OF PHARMACY will be followed for all the programs. Continuous assessment project work would be done as per THE DR. D. Y. PATIL COLLEGE OF PHARMACY norms, rules and notifications from time to time.
7. **RATES AND TAXES**  
Rates are in Rupees and Taxes as applicable shall be paid by DCS for its portion of fees received. Tax will be paid by either party as applicable.
8. **EXAMINATION FEE**  
Examination fee if applicable have to be paid jointly as per DR. D. Y. PATIL COLLEGE OF PHARMACY and DCS norms and shared as per clauses 4.
9. **PROFESSIONAL PRACTICE**  
DCS shall adhere to professional standards recognized by international professional bodies and shall observe sound academic, management and technical practices. The DCS shall always act in respect of any matter relating to their agreement, as faithful advisor to the DR. D. Y. PATIL COLLEGE OF PHARMACY and shall at all times, support and safeguard the legitimate interests of the DR. D. Y. PATIL COLLEGE OF PHARMACY in any dealing with the third party.
10. **PUBLICITY**  
Any publicity by the DCS in which the name / logo of DR. D. Y. PATIL COLLEGE OF PHARMACY is to be used shall be done only with the explicit written permission of DR. D. Y. PATIL COLLEGE OF PHARMACY, which shall not be withheld unreasonably. If DCS fails to do so, it shall be considered a breach of contract. DR. D. Y. PATIL COLLEGE OF PHARMACY will similarly take permission in written it with DCS LOGO/NAME.
11. **INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS**
  1. The copyright for existing and new material shall be held by the respective party who has developed it.
  2. If any program/ course is jointly developed then the copyright and any other intellectual property right shall be held jointly.



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12. **DETAILS OF EXPENSES**

Expenses by Dr. D. Y. Patil College of Pharmacy are Electricity expenses, Classroom utilities, marketing cost (Any marketing done by Dr. D. Y. Patil College Of Pharmacy) and Boarding & Lodging for DCS Team or DCS Industry Partners if required.

Expenses by DCS are teaching cost, Examination expenditure, Digital marketing, Promotional activities and Marketing cost (Any marketing done by DCS).

13. **VALIDITY AND RENEWAL**

The MoU shall be effective from the date of the Parties signatures hereto and shall continue to be operative for a period of five years and can be renewed further on mutually agreeable terms and conditions of both the parties.

14. **TERMINATION**

This MoU can be terminated by either of the Parties on six months' notice from either side for the violation of any of the terms and conditions of the MOU.

However, if the MoU is terminated for whatsoever reason, the responsibility of each Party shall continue to exist till the completion of the programme to which the students have been admitted before the date of servicing the notice termination.

15. **AMENDMENT**

The obligations of DCS and DR. D. Y. PATIL COLLEGE OF PHARMACY have been outlined in the MoU. However, during the operations of MoU, circumstances may arise which may call for alterations or modifications of this agreement. These will be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing. No amendment for change hereof or addition hereto shall be effective or binding on either of the parties hereto unless set in written and executed by the respective duly authorised representative of each of the parties hereto.

16. **FURTHER ACTS AND ASSURANCES**

Each of the parties agrees to execute and deliver all such further instruments and to do and perform all such further acts and things, as shall be necessary and required to carry out the provisions of this MoU and to consummate the transaction, contemplated hereby.

17. **MATTERS NOT PROVIDED HEREIN**

If any doubt arises as to the interpretation of the provisions of this MoU or as to matters not provided therein, the parties to this MoU shall each other for each instance and resolve such doubts in good faith.

18. **SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTE AND JURISDICTION**

If any dispute or difference of any kind whatsoever may arise between the parties in condition with or arising of this MoU or out of the breach, termination or invalidity of the MoU hereof, DCS and DR. D. Y. PATIL COLLEGE OF PHARMACY shall attempt for a period of 30 days after receipt of notice by the other party of the existence of a dispute to settle such dispute in the first instance by mutual discussion between the parties. If the dispute cannot be settled by mutual discussion within the 30 days as provided herein, only courts of PUNE will

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have the jurisdiction to adjudicate upon the matter. Courses will be completed by either party and degrees awarded to students already recruited as per DR. D. Y. PATIL COLLEGE OF PHARMACY / DCS records as on the date of the breakdown of mutual discussion.

**19. FORCE MAJEURE**

Neither DR. D. Y. PATIL COLLEGE OF PHARMACY nor DCS shall be liable to each other or to their students for failure or delay in the performance of any of its obligations under this MoU for the time and to the extent such failure or delay is caused by riots, civil commotion, wars, hostilities between nations, government loss, orders regulations, embargoes, action by the government(s) or any agency thereof act of God, storms, fires, accidents, strikes, sabotages, explosions, or other similar or different categories beyond the reasonable control of the respective parties to this MoU.

In the event that either party is wholly or in part, prevented from or hindered in carrying out or observing any of the terms or conditions of this MoU for any causes set forth hereinabove, such party shall give written notice to the other party by the most expeditious means as possible after the occurrence of the cause relied on, given full particulars of the reason for such prevention of hindrances, and the party shall in good faith consult each other and take necessary measures for the resolution of the affairs so prevented or hindered.

**20. GOVERNING LAW**

This MOU shall be governed and interpreted by and constituted in accordance with the subjective laws of India.

**21. CONFIDENTIALITY**

Parties undertaken to treat all commercial, financial, legal or other information, whether written or oral, concerning the Parties which is not available to the public at the date of this MOU, and which has been and/or could be disclosed by one of the Parties to the other, or by or to their respective representatives, employees, agents and advisers for the operations set out in this agreement and information, terms, conditions relating to these operations between the Parties, as Strictly private and confidential, and to take all necessary precautions to ensure that they remain strictly private and confidential.

**22. SEVERABILITY**

Any law restraining the validity and enforceability of any provision of this MoU shall not affect the validity or enforceability of the remaining, provisions of this MoU, hence, shall remain in full force and effect unless the invalid or unenforceable. Provisions comprises an integral part of or otherwise inseparable from the remaining agreement. In such a case, the parties of this MoU shall attempt to agree on a provision that is valid and enforceable and similar to the original provision.

**23. INDEMNIFICATION**

Both the parties shall indemnify and keep the other party indemnified and harmless against any and all claims, actions, proceedings by third party (including all costs, expenses, damages/ losses) arising out of or in connection

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with this MoU due to breach of any provisions of this MoU by such party or as a result of any act of negligence / omission or commission on part of such party and / or its employees, agents etc.

#### 24. REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES

The parties hereby represent and warrant to each other that:

- a. It is duly established and existing under the law of jurisdiction stated against its name of this MoU and has the legal power and authority to sign this MoU, perform and comply with its duties and obligations under this MoU;
- b. It has the requisite legal power and authority to enter in this MoU, perform and comply with its duties and obligations under this MoU, and the Project;
- c. This MoU constitutes legal, valid and binding obligations enforceable against it in accordance with the terms hereof;
- d. The execution, delivery and performance of this MoU have been duly authorised by all requisite action and will not constitute a violation of (i) any statute, judgment, order, decree or regulation of any court, government instrumentality or arbitral tribunal applicable or relating to itself, its assets, or its functions, or of (ii) any other documents or to the best of its knowledge any indenture, contract of MoU to which it is a party or by which it may be bound;
- e. There are no actions, suits or proceedings pending or, to the best knowledge threatened against it before any Court, Governmental instrumentality or arbitral tribunal that restrain it from performing its duties and obligations under this MoU; and
- f. No representation or warranty made herein contains any untrue statement.

Now this deed of **MOU** is agreed by and between the parties under following terms and conditions.

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS:**


1. **BOTH PARTIES** will share faculty expertise and instrumental facilities to each other as per mutual understanding.

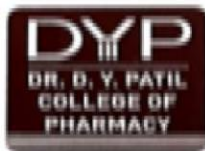


